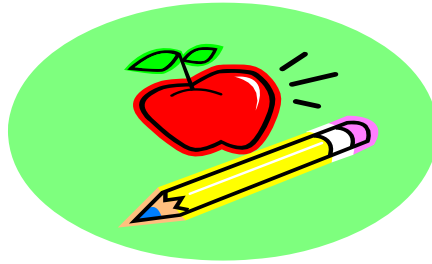


What Is The Role of the School Counselor in these Times of Great Anxiety for Schools, Parents, and Students?

Participants will enjoy a light breakfast and full lunch. Round table discussions will be continued during the luncheon.


